## *Weekly Gospel Reflection* *Reflexión semanal del evangelio*

On this Sunday, we continue to read from the sixth chapter of the Gospel of John. Today's Gospel elaborates further on the teaching that Jesus began in our liturgy last week. In that reading, the crowds wondered about how Jesus could say that he had come down from heaven because they knew Jesus to be the son of Joseph. In this Gospel, some have difficulty with Jesus' teaching that he is the living bread sent from God. Recall that Jesus had told them that just as God gave the Israelites manna to sustain them in the desert, so now God has sent new manna that will give eternal life. We hear the concluding verse of last week's Gospel repeated in today's reading: Jesus himself is the bread sent by God; Jesus' flesh is the bread that is given for the life of the world.

Among the stumbling blocks for those who heard but did not understand Jesus is the teaching that the bread that Jesus will give is his own flesh. In response to the people who quarreled over his words, Jesus teaches with even greater emphasis that salvation comes to those who eat his Body and Blood. Jesus doesn't seem to answer the question posed about how salvation will come about, perhaps because this reality can only be understood after his death and Resurrection. Instead, Jesus teaches about the life that he will give to the world.

To many ears, Jesus' words are jarring and difficult to hear. Many who heard Jesus could not accept what he said. Many today continue to struggle to accept these words. But they are important words because they reveal our intimate connection with Jesus.

This is the mystery that is at the heart of our eucharistic theology. In the elements of bread and wine, Jesus' Body and Blood are made truly present. When we share in the Body and Blood of Christ, Jesus himself comes to dwell within us. This communion with the Lord makes us one body, brings us eternal life, and sends us forth to be Christ's body for the life of the world.

*Este domingo continuamos leyendo el sexto capítulo del Evangelio de Juan. El Evangelio de hoy profundiza en la enseñanza que Jesús comenzó en nuestra liturgia la semana pasada. En esa lectura, la multitud se preguntaba cómo Jesús podía decir que había bajado del cielo porque sabían que Jesús era el hijo de José. En este Evangelio, algunos tienen dificultades con la enseñanza de Jesús de que él es el pan vivo enviado por Dios. Recuerde que Jesús les había dicho que así como Dios les dio maná a los israelitas para sustentarlos en el desierto, así ahora Dios ha enviado nuevo maná que les dará vida eterna. Escuchamos el versículo final del Evangelio de la semana pasada repetido en la lectura de hoy: Jesús mismo es el pan enviado por Dios; La carne de Jesús es el pan que se da para la vida del mundo.*

*Entre los obstáculos para quienes escucharon pero no entendieron a Jesús está la enseñanza de que el pan que Jesús dará es su propia carne. En respuesta a las personas que discutieron por sus palabras, Jesús enseña con aún mayor énfasis que la salvación llega a aquellos que comen su Cuerpo y Sangre. Jesús no parece responder a la pregunta planteada sobre cómo se producirá la salvación, tal vez porque esta realidad sólo podrá entenderse después de su muerte y resurrección. En cambio, Jesús enseña sobre la vida que dará al mundo.*

*Para muchos oídos, las palabras de Jesús son discordantes y difíciles de escuchar. Muchos de los que escucharon a Jesús no pudieron aceptar lo que dijo. Muchos hoy siguen luchando por aceptar estas palabras. Pero son palabras importantes porque revelan nuestra conexión íntima con Jesús.*

*Este es el misterio que está en el corazón de nuestra teología eucarística. En los elementos del pan y del vino, el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús se hacen verdaderamente presentes. Cuando compartimos el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo, Jesús mismo viene a habitar en nosotros. Esta comunión con el Señor nos hace un solo cuerpo, nos trae vida eterna y nos envía a ser el cuerpo de Cristo para la vida del mundo.*

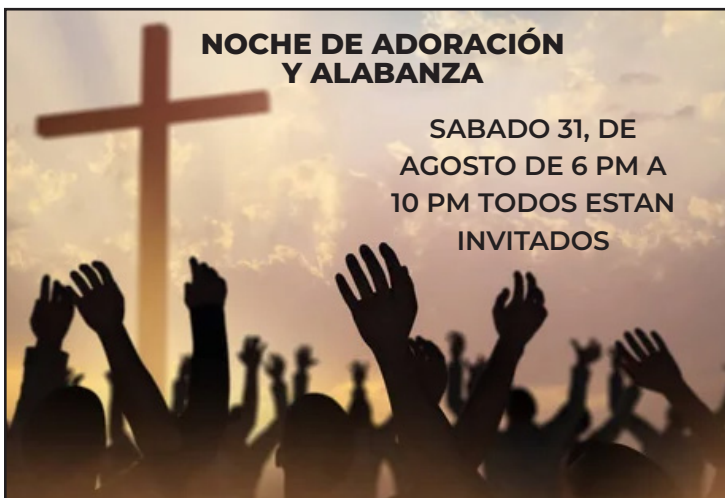

## FEAST DAY OF ST. ROSE OF LIMA FRIDAY, AUGUST 23<sup>RD</sup>

## FIESTA DE SANTA ROSA DE LIMA VIERNES 23 DE AGOSTO



St. Rose of Lima was the first person born in the Western Hemisphere to be canonized by the Roman Catholic Church. At a very young age, she chose to consecrate her life to God. She practiced very intense prayer and penance daily, sometimes depriving herself of food and sleep. She joined

the Third Order of St. Dominic and lived in a little hut in her parents' garden, working to help support them. She was ill for the last three years of her life and died at the age of 31 on August 24, 1617, feast of St. Bartholomew, as she herself prophesied. Her stained-glass window is on the left of the Sanctuary.

*Santa Rosa de Lima fue la primera persona nacida en el hemisferio occidental en ser canonizada por la Iglesia Católica Romana. Desde muy joven decidió consagrar su vida a Dios. Practicaba diariamente oración y penitencia muy intensa, privándose en ocasiones de alimento y sueño. Se unió a la Tercera Orden de Santo Domingo y vivió en una pequeña cabaña en el jardín de sus padres, trabajando para ayudarlos. Estuvo enferma los últimos tres años de su vida y murió a la edad de 31 años, el 24 de agosto de 1617, fiesta de San Bartolomé, como ella misma profetizó. Su vitral está a la izquierda del Santuario.*

## FEAST DAY OF ST. BARTHOLOMEW - SATURDAY, AUGUST 24<sup>TH</sup> FIESTA DE SAN BARTOLOMÉ - SÁBADO 24 DE AGOSTO

Saint Bartholomew was one of the original twelve Apostles. Being a close friend of Christ's, being transformed by Him, faithful to Him, and later evangelizing and giving up his life for Him, we look up to Saint Bartholomew as an example of holiness. As an Apostle, he is, as well, one of the foundational stones of the Church, and a source of her apostolic authority from Our Lord. His statue is on the left back wall of the church.

*San Bartolomé fue uno de los doce Apóstoles originales. Siendo un amigo cercano de Cristo, siendo transformados por Él, fieles a Él, y luego evangelizando y entregando su vida por Él, miramos a San Bartolomé como ejemplo de santidad. Como Apóstol, él es también una de las piedras fundamentales de la Iglesia y fuente de su autoridad apostólica de Nuestro Señor. Su estatua está en la pared trasera izquierda de la iglesia.*
