Weekly Gospel Reflection

Reflexión semanal del evangelio

Today we continue to hear the Gospel of Mark proclaimed. In today's reading, Jesus heals a man who was deaf and had a speech impediment. This is a story about Jesus' healing power, and in it we find clues about our understanding of sacrament. We are struck by the physical means used to heal the man, the use of spittle and touch. The Church continues to celebrate the sacraments using physical means. In the Sacrament of Baptism, water and oil are used to show the power of the Holy Spirit. In the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, we are anointed with holy oil on the forehead and the hands. In the Eucharist, bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ. We are a sacramental people who believe that God's grace is given to us through these physical signs.

Some, however, see in this Gospel an image of the proclamation of the good news of Jesus to the Gentiles. The geographic references tell us that Jesus is journeying through Gentile territory. Jesus had previously visited this region and healed a person possessed by a demon. Jesus was already famous there, which explains why people brought the deaf man to him. The story that precedes this reading in Mark's Gospel sets the stage. Jesus encounters a Gentile, a Syrophenician woman who asks him to heal her demon-possessed daughter. Jesus engages her in a dialogue about not feeding to dogs the food intended for children. Jesus is struck by the woman's great faith when she replies that even dogs eat the food that falls from the table, and he heals her daughter immediately. The faith of this Greek woman compels Jesus to respond to her plea.

Mark shows that Jesus' own mission affirms the early Church's mission to the Gentiles. This was a significant issue to the early Christian community, which found that the good news of Jesus took root and spread quickly among the Gentiles. Yet there is an irony in the story of healing that Mark tells. Jesus gives the man the gift of speech, but then tells him not to use it. Jesus asks that the news of his healing power, which is evidence of his identity as the Messiah, not be spread. This is a recurring motif in Mark's Gospel and is sometimes called the "messianic secret."

Hoy seguimos escuchando la proclamación del Evangelio de Marcos. En la lectura de hoy, Jesús sana a un hombre que era sordo y tenía un impedimento del habla. Esta es una historia sobre el poder sanador de Jesús y en ella encontramos pistas sobre nuestra comprensión del sacramento. Nos llama la atención los medios físicos utilizados para curar al hombre, el uso de la saliva y el tacto. La Iglesia continúa celebrando los sacramentos utilizando medios físicos. En el Sacramento del Bautismo, se utilizan agua y aceite para mostrar el poder del Espíritu Santo. En el Sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos, somos ungidos con el óleo santo en la frente y las manos. En la Eucaristía, el pan y el vino se convierten en Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo. Somos un pueblo sacramental que cree que la gracia de Dios se nos da a través de estos signos físicos.

Algunos, sin embargo, ven en este evangelio una imagen del anuncio de la buena nueva de Jesús a los gentiles. Las referencias geográficas nos dicen que Jesús está viajando por territorio gentil. Jesús había visitado previamente esta región y sanó a una persona poseída por un demonio. Jesús ya era famoso allí, lo que explica por qué la gente le trajo al sordo. La historia que precede a esta lectura en el Evangelio de Marcos prepara el escenario. Jesús se encuentra con una gentil, una mujer sirofenicia que le pide que sane a su hija endemoniada. Jesús la entabla un diálogo sobre no alimentar a los perros con comida destinada a los niños. Jesús queda impresionado por la gran fe de la mujer cuando ella responde que hasta los perros comen la comida que cae de la mesa, y él sana a su hija inmediatamente. La fe de esta mujer griega obliga a Jesús a responder a su petición.

Marcos muestra que la propia misión de Jesús afirma la misión de la Iglesia primitiva hacia los gentiles. Este fue un tema importante para la comunidad cristiana primitiva, que descubrió que las buenas nuevas de Jesús echaron raíces y se extendieron rápidamente entre los gentiles. Sin embargo, hay una ironía en la historia de curación que cuenta Marcos. Jesús le da al hombre el don de la palabra, pero luego le dice que no lo use. Jesús pide que no se difunda la noticia de su poder sanador, que es evidencia de su identidad como Mesías. Este es un motivo recurrente en el Evangelio de Marcos y a veces se le llama el "secreto mesiánico".

**FEAST OF ST. NOTBURGA - SATURDAY, SEPT. 14
FIESTA DE SANTA NOTBURGA - 14 DE SEPTIEMBRE**

St. Notburga, the patron of working women, was a peasant girl who became a servant in the household of Count Henry of Rattenberg. She was dismissed for giving food to the poor. Several misfortunes befell Count Henry, including the death of his wife, and he wasted no time in restoring Notburga to her former position. The inscription is "Pray and work," which is the motto of the Order of St. Benedict.

Santa Notburga, la patrona de las mujeres trabajadoras, era una campesina que se convirtió en sirvienta en la casa del conde Enrique de Rattenberg. La despidieron por dar comida a los pobres. El conde Enrique sufrió varias desgracias, incluida la muerte de su esposa, y no perdió tiempo en devolver a Notburga a su posición anterior. La inscripción es "Ora y trabaja", que es el lema de la Orden de San Benito.
