Weekly Gospel Reflection *Reflexión semanal del evangelio*

The context for today's Gospel continues to be mounting tension between Jesus and the Jewish authorities. Mark reports some of Jesus' teaching in the Temple area in today's reading and in the preceding verses not included in our Lectionary sequence. In the first part of today's Gospel, we hear Jesus warn the crowds not to follow the example of the scribes in seeking honor and attention from others. It is important to recall that Mark indicates that Jesus taught these things while in the vicinity of the Temple in Jerusalem. Mark is setting the stage for Jesus' passion.

Jesus then observes how Jewish pilgrims are making their contributions to the temple treasury. The Temple in Jerusalem was the center of Jewish worship in the time of Jesus. It was expected that observant Jews would make pilgrimages to the Temple to offer prayer and sacrifices. Pilgrims were also expected to make a financial contribution to the temple treasury.

As we would expect to be the case, Jesus observes that those who were rich contributed large sums to the treasury. Those with less means made smaller contributions. A similar situation exists in most of our parishes as well. Jesus calls attention, however, to a poor widow who makes the smallest of contributions—two coins of little value. Jesus upholds the poor widow's offering for his disciples' consideration, commending her because her small offering was an act of profound generosity, giving from her livelihood rather than her surplus.

To give from our livelihood is not only an act of generosity, it is also an act of trust in God. We can only give from our need if we trust that God will provide for us. Jesus himself demonstrates the ultimate act of generosity and trust in God as he gives his life for us on the cross.

El contexto del Evangelio de hoy sigue siendo la creciente tensión entre Jesús y las autoridades judías. Marcos relata algunas de las enseñanzas de Jesús en el área del Templo en la lectura de hoy y en los versículos anteriores que no están incluidos en nuestra secuencia del Leccionario. En la primera parte del Evangelio de hoy, escuchamos a Jesús advertir a las multitudes que no sigan el ejemplo de los escribas en la búsqueda de honor y atención de los demás. Es importante recordar que Marcos indica que Jesús enseñó estas cosas mientras estaba en las inmediaciones del Templo de Jerusalén. Marcos está preparando el escenario para la pasión de Jesús.

Jesús observa luego cómo los peregrinos judíos hacen sus contribuciones al tesoro del templo. El Templo de Jerusalén era el centro del culto judío en la época de Jesús. Se esperaba que los judíos observantes hicieran peregrinaciones al Templo para ofrecer oraciones y sacrificios. También se esperaba que los peregrinos hicieran una contribución financiera al tesoro del templo.

Como esperaríamos que fuera el caso, Jesús observa que los que eran ricos contribuían con grandes sumas al tesoro. Los que tenían menos medios hacían contribuciones más pequeñas. En la mayoría de nuestras parroquias también existe una situación similar. Sin embargo, Jesús llama la atención sobre una viuda pobre que hace una contribución mínima: dos monedas de poco valor. Jesús apoya la ofrenda de la viuda pobre para que sus discípulos la consideren, elogiándola porque su pequeña ofrenda fue un acto de profunda generosidad, al dar de su sustento en lugar de lo que le sobraba.

Dar de nuestro sustento no es solo un acto de generosidad, es también un acto de confianza en Dios. Solo podemos dar de nuestra necesidad si confiamos en que Dios proveerá para nosotros. Jesús mismo demuestra el máximo acto de generosidad y confianza en Dios al dar su vida por nosotros en la cruz.

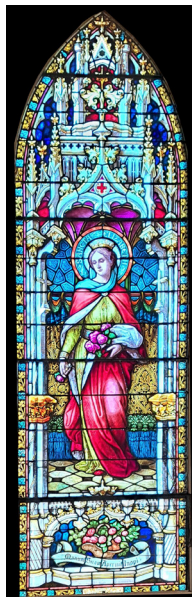

St. Elizabeth, at an early age, was given in marriage to Louis, son of the Landgrave of Thuringia. In spite of her position at court, she devoted herself to charity, penance and a simple life, and after Louis' death, she built a Franciscan hospital and devoted her life to caring for the sick. She died when 24 years old. The inscription found on the west third stained glass window of the nave is "She opened her hand to the needy."
